

CRAZY QUILTING CLASS
with Tippy Case



Crazy quilting can be creative, fun, and beautiful. In this class, we will fashion a 9x13” block that can become a pillow, wall hanging, or an evening bag. First, you will learn how to construct the piece – either by hand or machine. Then students will learn the embroidery stitches and beading techniques that embellish your quilt and make it sparkle.

Participants will need an 11x15” piece of muslin for the backing and scraps of cottons, velveteens, silks and satins of various colors. Embroidery floss and beads, lace edging, ribbons and buttons will be used for embellishment.

Please bring basic sewing supplies to class: sewing and embroidery needles, pins, scissors, rulers, marking pens, threads, and other sewing notions.
