

**PAINTING AND DRAWING WORKSHOP**  
**with Gage Beck-Witt**

For the winter months, participants will be introduced to miniature painting. The canvases are 2" x 2", 2.5" x 2.5", or 3" x 3"...and they come with tiny easels. Remember to bring very small nylon brushes and some ideas about what you'd like to paint in this miniature format.

Landscapes and more! Participants in this course can paint a landscape with oil or acrylic paint. Please bring a canvas (at least 12" x 12", bigger is better) pencils, eraser, drawing pad, a large palette, 3-6 brushes of different sizes (white nylon is reasonably priced and is fine for this course), and at least 10 tubes of paint. The instructor will have a photo to draw from, or you may bring one of your own. If you do bring a photo, it is recommended that you don't bring a photo of someone else's painting to follow. You may bring a photo of your favorite thing to paint. You should avoid pets and portraits, because they are difficult for beginners to paint.
