

**NEW YORK STATE YOUNG BOATER'S COURSE
RESIDENTS ONLY!**



This five-lesson course for resident youth ages 10-17 will be taught by the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 18-8. Registration is mandatory and upon successful completion of the course, a state certificate will be issued enabling participants to legally operate a motorboat on their own.

This course is offered at no cost to Southold Town residents only. New York State mandates that participants must attend all five (5) sessions in order to receive a certificate.

ADULT BOATING SAFETY COURSE



This six course for adults (ages 17 and over) will be taught by the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla 18-08. Topics covered include: Boat Handling and Operation, Navigating The Waterways, Boating Emergencies, Personal Watercraft, Legal and Safety Requirements, Marine Radio, and Watersports. The course has been developed to support the particular needs of the novice and average boater in this area. Course materials must be picked up and read prior to the first class. A certificate will be awarded upon successful completion of the course. This certificate satisfies the NY State requirement to operate a Personal Watercraft, and may entitle you to an insurance discount on your boat.
